

Overdose Awareness: Naloxone (Narcan) Training

Training topics will include:

- education about the opiate issue and how it got started
- how to identify opiate intoxication
- how to identify an opiate overdose
- how to respond to an opiate overdose
- how to administer Naloxone

Learning how to spot an overdose is the first step in saving someone's life. Overdose can happen whether using a prescribed medication or from illicit drug use.

Adults who attend the training will be offered a Naloxone kit to take with them, free of charge! (While supplies last.)
